

The United Nations Pact for the Future

A Summary of Actions¹

I. Sustainable development and financing for development

We will:

1. Take bold, ambitious, accelerated, just and transformative actions to implement the 2030 Agenda, achieve the Sustainable Development Goals and leave no one behind.
2. Place the eradication of poverty at the centre of our efforts to achieve the 2030 Agenda.
3. End hunger and eliminate food insecurity and all forms of malnutrition.
4. Close the Sustainable Development Goal financing gap in developing countries.
5. Ensure that the multilateral trading system continues to be an engine for sustainable development.
6. Invest in people to end poverty and strengthen trust and social cohesion.
7. Strengthen our efforts to build peaceful, just and inclusive societies for sustainable development, provide access to justice for all and build effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels and uphold human rights and fundamental freedoms.
8. Achieve gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls as a crucial contribution to progress across all the Sustainable Development Goals and targets.
9. Strengthen our actions to address climate change.
10. Accelerate our efforts to restore, protect, conserve and sustainably use the environment.
11. Protect and promote culture and sport as integral components of sustainable development.
12. Plan for the future and strengthen our collective efforts to turbocharge the full implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development by 2030 and beyond.

II. International peace and security

We will:

13. Redouble our efforts to build and sustain peaceful, inclusive and just societies and address the root causes of conflicts.
14. Protect all civilians in armed conflict.
15. Ensure that people affected by humanitarian emergencies receive the support they need.
16. Promote cooperation and understanding between Member States, defuse tensions, seek the pacific settlement of disputes and resolve conflicts.
17. Fulfil our obligation to comply with the decisions and uphold the mandate of the International Court of Justice in any case to which our State is a party.
18. Build and sustain peace.
19. Accelerate the implementation of our commitments on women, peace and security.
20. Accelerate the implementation of our commitments on youth, peace and security.
21. Adapt peace operations to better respond to existing challenges and new realities.
22. Address the serious impact of threats to maritime security and safety.
23. Pursue a future free from terrorism.
24. Prevent and combat transnational organized crime and related illicit financial flows.
25. Advance the goal of a world free of nuclear weapons.
26. Uphold our disarmament obligations and commitments.
27. Seize the opportunities associated with new and emerging technologies and address the potential risks posed by their misuse.

III. Science, technology and innovation and digital cooperation

We will:

28. Seize the opportunities presented by science, technology and innovation for the benefit of people and planet.
29. Scale up the means of implementation to developing countries to strengthen their science, technology and innovation capacities.
30. Ensure that science, technology and innovation contribute to the full enjoyment of human rights by all.
31. Ensure that science, technology and innovation improve gender equality and the lives of all women and girls.
32. Protect, build on and complement Indigenous, traditional and local knowledge.
33. Support the Secretary-General to strengthen the role of the United Nations in supporting international cooperation in science, technology and innovation.

IV. Youth and future generations

We will:

34. Invest in the social and economic development of children and young people so that they can reach their full potential.
35. Promote, protect and respect the human rights of all young people and foster social inclusion and integration.
36. Strengthen meaningful youth participation at the national level.
37. Strengthen meaningful youth participation at the international level.

V. Transforming global governance

We will:

38. Transform global governance and reinvigorate the multilateral system to tackle the challenges, and seize the opportunities, of today and tomorrow.
39. Reform the Security Council, recognizing the urgent need to make it more representative, inclusive, transparent, efficient, effective, democratic and accountable.
40. Strengthen our efforts in the framework of the intergovernmental negotiations on Security Council reform as a matter of priority and without delay.
41. Strengthen the response of the Security Council for the maintenance of international peace and security and its relationship with the General Assembly.
42. Increase our efforts to revitalize the work of the General Assembly.
43. Strengthen the Economic and Social Council to accelerate sustainable development.
44. Strengthen the Peacebuilding Commission.
45. Strengthen the United Nations system.
46. Ensure the effective enjoyment by all of all human rights and respond to new and emerging challenges.
47. Accelerate reform of the international financial architecture to address the challenges of today and tomorrow.
48. Accelerate reform of the international financial architecture to strengthen the voice and representation of developing countries.
49. Accelerate reform of the international financial architecture to mobilize additional financing for the Sustainable Development Goals, respond to the needs of developing countries and direct financing to those most in need.
50. Accelerate the reform of the international financial architecture so that countries can borrow sustainably to invest in their long-term development.
51. Accelerate the reform of the international financial architecture to strengthen its capacity to support developing countries more effectively and equitably during systemic shocks and make the financial system more stable.
52. Accelerate the reform of the international financial architecture so that it can meet the urgent challenge of climate change.
53. Develop a framework on measures of progress on sustainable development to complement and go beyond gross domestic product.
54. Strengthen the international response to complex global shocks.
55. Strengthen our partnerships to deliver on existing commitments and address new and emerging challenges.
56. Strengthen international cooperation for the exploration and use of outer space for peaceful purposes and for the benefit of all humanity.
